Cobb Floor Amendment

Amends the Appropriations Committee strike everything amendment to do the following:

- Reduces the FY 21 General Fund appropriation for State Parks operating costs from \$5 million to \$3 million.
- Adds a \$2 million FY 21 appropriation for State Parks operating cost from the State Parks Revenue Fund (SPRF).
- Adds "administration" to the purposes of SPRF.
- Allows monies in the State Lake Improvement Fund to be used for "water search and rescue operations".

1 Page 1, between lines 17 and 18, insert:

2 "2. FOR WATER SEARCH AND RESCUE OPERATIONS."

3 Line 18, strike "2." Insert "3."

4 Page 2, between lines 20 and 21, insert:

5 "Sec. 2. Section 41-511.21, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
6 read:

7 41-511.21. State parks revenue fund; purpose; exemption

8 A. The state parks revenue fund is established consisting of:

9 1. Monies received from the sale of park posters, park postcards,
10 books, souvenirs and sundry items pursuant to section 41-511.05, paragraph
11 4.

12 2. Monies appropriated by the legislature for the purpose of
13 enhancing state parks.

14 3. Unconditional gifts and donations specifically designated to the
15 revenue fund, except for unconditional gifts, donations, bequests and
16 endowments deposited in the state parks donations fund pursuant to section
17 41-511.11.

18 4. All monies derived from state park user fees, concession fees and
19 other revenue generating activities.

20 5. Surcharges on park reservations.

21 6. Sale of park assets.

22 B. The monies in the fund are subject to legislative appropriation:

23 1. For the operation, ADMINISTRATION and maintenance of the state
24 park system.

1 2. For use by the board to acquire and develop real property and
2 improvements as state parks consistent with the purposes and objectives
3 prescribed in section 41-511.03, subject to review by the joint committee
4 on capital review.

5 C. Monies in the fund shall not be appropriated in a manner that is
6 inconsistent with restrictions in the lease or deed to the property.

7 D. The board may collect monies as a surcharge on park reservations
8 and shall determine the surcharge rate as provided in section 41-511.05,
9 paragraph 8 after considering the costs to plan and administer the
10 reservation system.

11 E. On notice from the board, the state treasurer shall invest and
12 divest the monies in the state parks revenue fund as provided by section
13 35-313, and monies earned from investment shall be credited to the fund.

14 F. Monies in the state parks revenue fund are exempt from section
15 35-190, relating to lapsing of appropriations. The purposes for which
16 monies were expended during the preceding fiscal year shall be delineated
17 in the agency's annual report pursuant to section 41-511.12."

25 operating costs."
