

## HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION



Bill Number: **HB 2764**

Weninger Floor Amendment

1. Changes identification card display requirement from "AZDIFI" to "AZDOI."
2. Allows DOI to request additional data from an insurer that is necessary to verify compliance with the Act.
3. Requires the website developed by DOI to display a link to the U.S. Department of Labor website or a related site that provides information on consumer appeals or complaints.
4. Changes the date by which DOI must post a summary of reports from January 1, 2022 to January 1, 2023.
5. Mandates that mental health services provided in a school setting comply with parental consent laws.
6. Specifies that the Committee must have at least three members or family members who are not employed by the state who have been affected by suicide, substance abuse or mental health disorder.
7. Requires the Committee to have at least one member who represents a hospital that provides inpatient behavioral health services.
8. Adds to the Team a health care professional from a statewide association representing nurses.
9. Specifies that a member of the Team may only request information from a relative of a person who died by suicide if approved by the Team.
10. Stipulates that children who receive behavioral health services paid by the Fund must:
  - a) Be within the legal age requirements for school admission at the time the student was admitted and be enrolled in school;
  - b) Be uninsured or underinsured;
  - c) Be referred by an educational institution;
  - d) Have written parental consent to obtain services;
  - e) Receive services from a licensed professional who is a contracted provider; and
  - f) Receive services on or off school grounds.
11. Allows AHCCCS to impose cost sharing requirements on a sliding fee scale for services provided by contractors.
12. Specifies that before a school can provide referrals for behavioral health services, the governing board must adopt policies relating to school-based referrals, including:

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- a) A process to allow parents to annually opt into school-based referrals;
  - b) A process to conduct a survey of parents whose children received services pursuant to this section, which must contain at least the following:
    - i. Whether the parent opted into the program;
    - ii. Whether the parent was notified before the referral took place;
    - iii. Whether the services referred were appropriate for the student's needs;
    - iv. Whether the parent is satisfied with the choice of providers; and
    - v. Whether the parent intends to opt into a program again; and
  - c) A requirement that the school website have a list of contracted providers.
13. Requires schools to annually report to AHCCCS the survey results.
  14. Requires AHCCCS to compile the survey results and provide a report.
  15. Strikes the requirement for the Department of Education to contract with a research entity to conduct a study to determine the adequacy of behavioral health services offered in school districts.
  16. Mandates that AHCCCS conduct a survey of public schools to obtain information on the referral of behavioral health services to students and provide a report on the survey by December 31, 2022.
  17. Adjusts the date by which DOI must adopt rules from January 1, 2022 to April 1, 2021.
  18. Specifies that DOI may allow insurers to demonstrate compliance with this act by means at least as comprehensive as the forms or worksheets required by this act.
  19. Requires rules adopted by DHS to include providing information to patients and caregivers on a continuum during the stay, including at admission and discharge.
  20. Strikes the appropriation to the Department of Education.
  21. Increases the appropriation to DOI from \$200,000 to \$250,000.
  22. Specifies that the appropriation to the Children's Behavioral Health Services Fund lapses June 30, 2022.
  23. Makes technical and conforming changes.

12 RETIREMENT INCOME SECURITY ACT OF 1974 (P.L. 93-406; 88 STAT. 829)."

14 Page 6, line 31, after "PRIVACY" insert "AND PARENTAL CONSENT"

16 MEMBERS WHO ARE NOT EMPLOYED BY OR CONTRACTED WITH THE STATE AND"

17 Between lines 9 and 10, insert:

18 "5. AT LEAST ONE MEMBER WHO REPRESENTS A HOSPITAL THAT PROVIDES  
19 INPATIENT BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES."

21 "9. A HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL FROM A STATEWIDE ASSOCIATION

18 4. HAVE WRITTEN PARENTAL CONSENT TO OBTAIN THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH  
19 SERVICES.

20 5. RECEIVE THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES BY A CONTRACTED LICENSED  
21 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROVIDER.

22 6. RECEIVE THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES ON OR OFF SCHOOL GROUNDS.

31 A. BEFORE A SCHOOL PROVIDES SCHOOL-BASED REFERRALS FOR BEHAVIORAL  
32 HEALTH SERVICES TO A CONTRACTED BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES PROVIDER EITHER

1 PURSUANT TO THE CHILDREN'S BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES FUND ESTABLISHED BY  
2 SECTION 36-3436 OR FOR SERVICES PROVIDED THROUGH THE ARIZONA HEALTH CARE  
3 COST CONTAINMENT SYSTEM, THE SCHOOL DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARD OR CHARTER  
4 SCHOOL GOVERNING BODY SHALL ADOPT POLICIES RELATING TO SCHOOL-BASED  
5 REFERRALS. THESE POLICIES SHALL BE VETTED AT A PUBLIC MEETING IN WHICH THE  
6 SCHOOL DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARD OR CHARTER SCHOOL GOVERNING BODY CONSIDERS  
7 ANY COMMENTS SUBMITTED BY THE PUBLIC BEFORE THE GOVERNING BOARD OR  
8 GOVERNING BODY ADOPTS THE POLICIES. THE SCHOOL DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARD OR  
9 CHARTER SCHOOL GOVERNING BODY SHALL POST THE POLICES ADOPTED PURSUANT TO  
10 THIS SECTION ON EACH APPLICABLE SCHOOL WEBSITE. THE POLICIES SHALL INCLUDE  
11 THE FOLLOWING:

12 1. A PROCESS TO ALLOW A PARENT TO ANNUALLY OPT INTO THE SCHOOL-BASED  
13 REFERRALS.

14 2. A PROCESS TO CONDUCT A SURVEY OF PARENTS WHOSE CHILDREN WERE  
15 REFERRED TO AND RECEIVED BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES PURSUANT TO THIS  
16 SECTION. THE SURVEY MAY BE COMPLETED ONLINE. THE SURVEY SHALL INCLUDE AT  
17 LEAST THE FOLLOWING:

18 (a) WHETHER THE PARENT OPTED INTO THE PROGRAM.

19 (b) WHETHER THE PARENT WAS NOTIFIED BEFORE THE REFERRAL TOOK PLACE.

20 (c) WHETHER THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES REFERRED WERE APPROPRIATE  
21 TO MEET THE STUDENT'S NEED.

22 (d) WHETHER THE PARENT IS SATISFIED WITH THE CHOICE OF BEHAVIORAL  
23 HEALTH SERVICES PROVIDERS.

24 (e) WHETHER THE PARENT INTENDS TO OPT INTO A PROGRAM AGAIN IN THE  
25 FOLLOWING SCHOOL YEAR.

26 3. A REQUIREMENT THAT EACH SCHOOL'S WEBSITE CONTAIN A LIST OF  
27 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES PROVIDERS WITH WHOM THE SCHOOL CONTRACTS.

28 B. AT THE END OF EACH SCHOOL YEAR, EACH PARTICIPATING SCHOOL  
29 DISTRICT AND CHARTER SCHOOL SHALL REPORT TO THE ADMINISTRATION THE SCHOOL  
30 SURVEY RESULTS.

1 C. THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL COMPILE A REPORT BASED ON THE SURVEYS  
2 RECEIVED FROM PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND CHARTER SCHOOLS AS WELL AS  
3 UTILIZATION DATA FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES RECEIVED PURSUANT TO THE  
4 CHILDREN'S BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES FUND ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 36-3436.  
5 ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31 EACH YEAR, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL PROVIDE THE  
6 REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR, THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE  
7 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND PROVIDE A COPY OF THE REPORT TO THE SECRETARY  
8 OF STATE. THE REPORT SHALL INCLUDE AT LEAST ALL OF THE FOLLOWING  
9 INFORMATION:

- 10 1. THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS SERVED.
- 11 2. THE TYPES OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES PROVIDED.
- 12 3. THE COSTS OF THE BEHAVIOR HEALTH SERVICES PROVIDED."

18 A. The Arizona health care cost containment system shall conduct a  
19 survey of public schools to obtain information regarding the referral of  
20 behavioral health services to students by contracted licensed behavioral  
21 health providers. The survey shall include all of the following:

- 22 1. The types of behavioral health providers providing the services.
- 23 2. The types of settings where behavioral health services were  
24 delivered to students.
- 25 3. The number of students who received services.

26 4. The most common diagnoses that resulted in the need for services.

27 B. On or before December 31, 2022, the Arizona health care cost  
28 containment system shall provide a copy of the result of the survey to the  
29 governor, the president of the senate and the speaker of the house of  
30 representatives and provide a copy of the report to the secretary of state.

31 C. This section is repealed from and after June 30, 2023."
