2 "A. For the benefit of students enrolled in public schools that have
3 closed as a result of the statewide closure, each public school in this
4 state shall continue to pay its employees, including hourly employees, from
5 March 16, 2020 through March 29, 2020 if an employee is committed to being
6 available to work during the employee's normal work hours. The public
7 school may not require any employee to use accrued vacation or sick leave
8 for the duration of the closure."

16 Notwithstanding any other law, through June 30, 2021, the
17 superintendent of public instruction, only with the approval of the state
18 board of education, may waive any school finance requirement necessary to
19 implement section 1 of this act for school finance matters related to the
20 2019-2020 school year only."
